

Bhaktapur and Boudhanath Cultural Tour - Full day



Located 13km east of Kathmandu, Bhaktapur is a UNESCO World Heritage site, famed for its rich culture, temples, and wood, metal and stone artwork and is still relatively untouched. It is the home of traditional art, architecture, historical monuments, pottery and weaving industries, temples, beautiful ponds, rich local customs, culture, religion and festivals.



Bhaktapur Durbar Square has many pagoda and shikhara-style temples grouped around a 55-window palace of brick and wood. The square is one of the most charming architectural showpieces of the Kathmandu valley as it highlights the ancient arts of Nepal.



Boudhanath is a UNESCO World Heritage site, not only is it one of the largest stupas in the world, it is also the one of the holiest Buddhist sites in Kathmandu . The stupa's massive mandala makes it one of the largest spherical stupas in Nepal.
