

Boudhanath, Pashupatinath and Swayambhunath Cultural Tour - Full Day



Boudhanath is a UNESCO World Heritage site, not only is it one of the largest stupas in the world, it is also the one of the holiest Buddhist sites in Kathmandu. The stupa's massive mandala makes it one of the largest spherical stupas in Nepal.



Swayambhunath, an ancient religious complex sits on top of a hill to the west of Kathmandu city, an exhausting 365 steps to reach the top! It is also known as the Monkey Temple as there are holy monkeys living in the north-west parts of the temple. As one of the most sacred Buddhist pilgrimage sites, it still plays an important role in their day-to-day religious practice.



Pashupatinath on the banks of the holy Bagmati River, is Nepal's most important Hindu temple, where Shiva is celebrated as Pashupati, lord of the beasts. Only Hindus are allowed to enter the main temple but anyone can visit the surrounding complex. On the banks of the Bagmati River, funeral ghats are used for open-air cremations.
